



## **Underground Storage Tank Notice of Proposed Rulemaking**

Some of you have underground storage tanks and should review the following notice.

### **[Notice Of Public Hearing Proposed Amendments To Underground Storage Tank Regulations](#)**

This Notice of Proposed Rulemaking (Notice) is concerning the Underground Storage Tank (UST) Program regulations contained in Chapter 16 of Title 23 of the California Code of Regulations. As described in the Notice, the proposed regulations will amend references to UST operating permit application "Form A," "Form B," and "Form C" throughout Title 23, Chapter 16. They specify that UST owners and operators use a new standard form for submitting new and previously required information on procedures for monitoring. They also revise unclear sections and incorrect citations and references within Title 23, Chapter 16.

The UST operating permit application forms "Form A," "Form B" and "Form C" are located in Title 27 and are only referenced in Title 23. Please note that proposed changes to the title and content of these Title 27 forms are the subject of a separate rulemaking proceeding before CalEPA. CalEPA held a public hearing and closed its comment period for proposed changes to the title and content of these forms on May 11, 2007.

The Notice contains detailed information about the scheduled public hearing. To ensure that all attendees have a chance to participate in the hearing, oral comments may be limited to ten minutes or less. It is suggested that persons wishing to present comment register for the hearing. Registration will begin at 1:00 p.m. The hearing will close at 5 p.m. or 30 minutes after the last speaker has presented comments, whichever is sooner.

Jessie Street Closes to Tour Buses and Other Traffic – (behind the Old Mint on 5th St. @ Mission St., San Francisco)

Jessie Street between Mint and 5th Streets has been closed to all traffic, and will be rebuilt as a pedestrian plaza, to open in September. Therefore, tour bus parking and circulation on Mint Street will no longer be available. Alternate tour bus parking is available near the Bay Bridge at Pier 30. ## **Speed limit lowered on Highway 149**

Butte County - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) has lowered the speed limit on Highway 149 from 65 M.P.H. to 55 M.P.H. due to increased construction vehicle activity.

The work being done is part of a \$105 million project to make the highway a four-lane expressway with freeway-to-freeway interchanges at the intersections of Highways 70/149 and Highways 99/149. Completion is expected in 2009.

Caltrans urges all motorists to use caution in this area and to "Slow for the Cone Zone".
